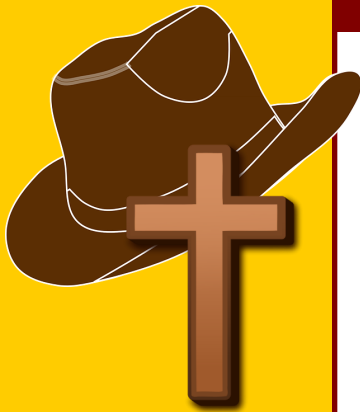




# Tonganoxie Community Historical Society Presentation
