## Paul & Frank's Son: The Life and Loss of Creighton Siegert



The presentation will summarize the life of Creighton Siegert and the circumstances of his loss during World War II. Creighton was the only child of Paul and Frances (Frank) Siegert who were the longtime owners and operators of the West End Lunch in Tonganoxie. Creighton graduated from Tonganoxie High School in May 1942. He enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps in December 1942 and was lost over Germany on April 8, 1944 during his first and only mission as a radio operator on a B-24 heavy bomber.

Presentation by Jon D. Nelson, P.E. Jon is a 1970 graduate of Tonganoxie High School, and has a BS degree in civil engineering from Kansas State University, an MS degree in environmental engineering from Oklahoma State University and a love of history.
