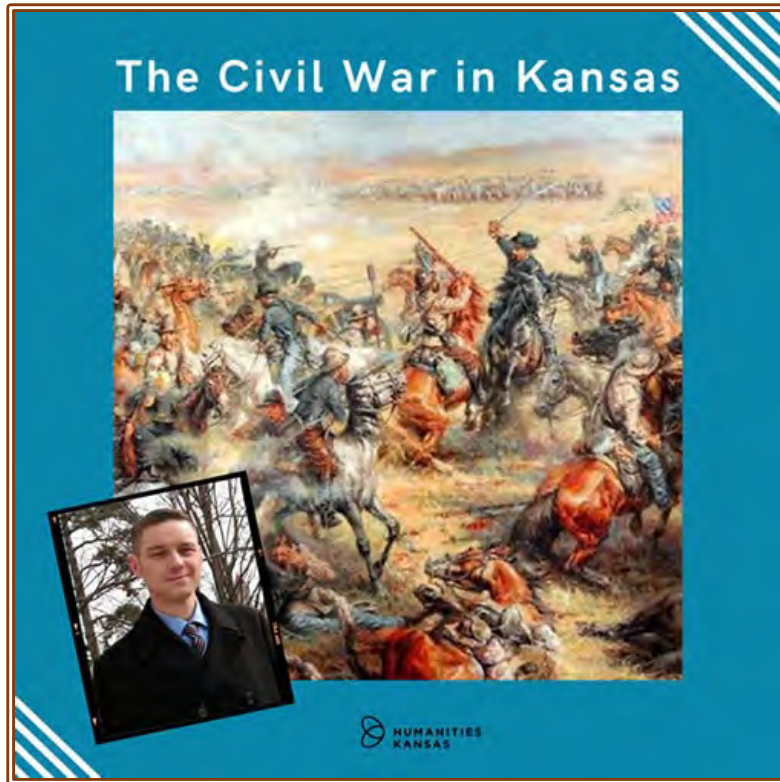


Fourth Tuesday Program
